This is designed for a motif of plaid which is one of the features of the Budokan building.

Five rectangles represent [K] sign, the first letter of Kanagawa and also image for further advance.

Three white small rectangles emphasize it.

One rectangle that is separated from others represents stability and calmness of the Budo.

[K] which opens to right-hand side represents receptiveness for new things, expandability and internationality.

The symbol color, deep blue shows philosophy of the Budo. Also it shows harmony and dignity which the Budo has.

Chronology of Kanagawa prefectural Budokan

Former Budokan

1928	Planned the Budokan construction as an anniversary for an enthronement ceremony
1934	The prefectural budget ¥174,323 recorded by the cooperation of the related organizations and general benefactors
1935	Construction started at Yokohama Koen Naka ward Yokohama city which is a free loan from Yokohama city
1936	Construction completed / Opening ceremony in Nov. Since then, it belonged to Kanagawa prefectural board of education
1946	Takenover by the occupation troops and used as a meeting place
1952	Released from seizure, but was continuously used as a club for the occupation troops
1958	Returned from the occupation troops, it was managed by the Kanagawa prefectural board of education
1959	Restoration undertook in Feb. Opening ceremony in Jun. Restarted as a central prefecture Budo place that targeted judo, kendo and kyudo
1977	Transferred the Budokan to Yokohama city for the Yokohama stadium construction in Aug. Temporary Budo place transferred from Yokohama city in Yokohama park until the current Budokan construction completed

Current Budokan

1980	Conducted research design for the current Budokan construction by limited design competition
1981	The construction started at Kishine koen Kohoku ward Yokohama city in May which is a free loan from Yokohama city
1982	Construction completed with a total cost of about ¥ 1,530,000,000 in May. Opening ceremony in Jul. continuously belonged to Kanagawa Prefectural Board of Education
1992	the 10th anniversary party held
2002	the 20th anniversary
2007	the 25th anniversary
2010	Made a contract of a facility management to a private company (Tokyu community corp.) by the designated manager system
2012	the 30th anniversary
